Paragraph 13 is deleted from the Local Plan by MM80 (and not replaced by MM81). Paragraph 13 read - Ensure a drainage strategy is in place, in consultation with the Local Planning Authority, Kent County Council as the Drainage Authority, **and Southern Water prior to the grant of planning permission** for any substantial development on the site, unless exceptional circumstances arise. This should demonstrate that there is adequate capacity in the foul sewage network, and that development will not exacerbate flooding elsewhere. The drainage strategy should be implemented through the development to deliver the levels of storage, attenuation, and mitigation measures to reduce the incidence of flooding to adjacent residential areas in Paddock Wood;

Southern Water is a key consultee for drainage strategy and masterplans for this location in particular given nearby assets and infrastructure (but water companies are not statutory consultees at planning stage). Given the removal of paragraph 13, and without comprehensive wording sufficient to ensure we are consulted on the master planning for such a strategic site, we request that wording is added to ensure that Southern Water is consulted on Masterplans for this site, and at planning application consultation stage, with reference to drainage strategy in particular but also to ensure planning for each parcel of the development accounts for any odour modelling and layout needs that may be relevant, as well as easements for public sewerage infrastructure.
