We note that the following states:

 a. sports and leisure provision to include an upgrade to existing indoor and outdoor sports facilities (which shall include a 25m swimming pool if feasible);
Any new sporting provision should be based on robust evidence as per paragraph 103 of the National Planning Policy Guidance December 2024. Turnbridge Wells Built

Facility Strategy, (BFS) is out of date and is not considered robust. We would strongly urge TWBC to carry out a new BFS with the backing of running our Planning Facility Model, (FPM) if this policy is not to be challenged by external developers.

We would also suggest, that TWBC also renews its outdated playing pitch strategy at the same time.
